Chairman McCasland, along with Richard Primrose, recognized Susan Lease, former Quay County DWI Preventionist for her 18 years of service to Quay County. Lease has resigned her position.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ellen White, Quay County Clerk, presented the following items of information:

1. 2019 Board of Registration Purge results and certification. White reported 175 inactive voters were removed from the voting database as a result of the 2019 Purge.
2. 2019 Quay County Occupation License Update. White stated the third and final notice to renew licensure will be mailed at the end of this week.

Copies of both reports are attached to these minutes.

Renee Hayoz, Presbyterian Medical Services Administrator, presented the monthly RPHCA Reports for the time period ending February 28, 2019. A copy is attached to these minutes.

Russell Shafer, Quay County Sheriff, requested approval of the 2019-2020 Law Enforcement Protection Funds Grant Application in the amount of \$24,200.00. 



The Board of Registration was called to order by Sylvia A. Wampler, The Oath of Office was given to the Board Members and filed by the County Clerk. The Board proceeded to check the list of voters that was compiled by the Secretary of State based on those voters who had not voted in the last four years in either federal election cycles or any local elections and also had not made an address change during the last two years. The Secretary of State did a computer comparison against the National Change of Address (NCOA) database and the Secretary of State's statewide voter database to develop the list.

The Board of Registration checked each voter on the list via the County Clerk's computer/print-out to determine each voter's voting history and if they had made a change of address during the same time period. The process was complete with the removal of the 175 voters as recommended to be purged.

Upon verification that all the correct Affidavits or Registration had been pulled, 175 cards were signed by the Chairman of the Board of Registration and purged from the Quay County voter database.

Chairman Wampler declared the meeting of the Board of Registration adjourned.






