ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SELECTION OF CHAIRMAN OF THE QUAY
COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners must appoint a chairman to
preside over the County Commissioners at each and
every meeting; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico during their regular session
of the 1990, signed into law House Bill #339 establish-
ing definite criteria in this matter:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Quay Board of County
Commissioners, Tucumcari, New Mexico, that House
Bill #339 be adopted, reading as follows:

Section 1. Section 4-38-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1876,
Chapter 1, Section 17, as amended) is amended to read:

"4-38-10. CHAIRMAN

A. The county commssioners shall, at the first meeting of
each year, choose one of their number chairman, who shall
preside at that meeting and all other meetings during that
year if present; but in case of his absence from that
meeting, the numbers present shall choose one of their
number as temporary chairman.

B. A county commissioner shall not serve as chairman in
consecutive years unless that county commissioners is
chosen as chairman at the first meeting of each year.

C. The chairman of the county commission shall be elected
by a majority vote of the county commissioners and may at
any time be removed by a majority vote of the county
commission."

Section 2. Emergency - - its necessary for the public
peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 9.D OF CHAPTER 6, LAWS OF NEW MEXICO, 1990 THE RETIREE HEALTH CARE ACT, EXERCISING THE IRREVOCABLE OPTION TO DETERMINE TO BE EXCLUDED FROM COVERAGE UNDER THE RETIREE HEALTH CARE ACT

WHEREAS, The Quay County Board of Commissioners has considered the issue of retiree health care for its employees, retirees, their spouses and dependents; and

WHEREAS, The Quay County Board of Commissioners has considered the opportunity afforded by Chapter 6, Laws of New Mexico, 1990 to provide retiree health coverages at a single rate of \$50-\$55. per month and a maximum of 3 % annual increases funded with a 1 % and 1/2 % employer/employee contribution; and

WHEREAS, The Quay County Board of Commissioners determines to exclude the Quay County Government, its employees and retirees from the retiree benefits under the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Board of Quay County Commissioners:

Section 1. Thirty days prior to public hearing on this Ordinance, as required by Section 9.D. (2) of the Retiree Health Care Authority was notified by certified mail of the public hearing on this Ordinance.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 9.D of Chapter 5, Laws of New Mexico 1990 the Board of Quay County Commissioners determines to be excluded from coverage under the Retiree Health Care Act.
