Brenda Bishop, Quay County Extension Office Program Director presented the Quarterly Report ending September 30, 2018. A copy is attached to these minutes.

Larry Moore, Quay County Road Superintendent presented the following road updates:

1. Quay Road AI is complete and paperwork is being finished to close out the project.
2. Blade Reports are attached to these minutes. The crews have been very busy due to recent rainfall.
3. Prepping on Quay Road 60 and Quay Road 64 in the San Jon area has started. Documents to receive the millings from the State have not been received yet for this project.
4. Stantec has performed geo-tech drilling samples on Quay Road AI and Quay Road AR.

Commissioner Dowell asked if any additional correspondence has been made or received regarding the cattle guard issue in state right-of-ways. Moore and Primrose both responded saying nothing new has developed.

Commissioner Dowell stated Scott Bidegain had called regarding a road. Primrose reported he has already spoken to Bidegain. Dowell said Larry Hines requested information regarding an environmental study that was conducted near him. Moore stated he would call him.

Commissioner Cherry stated he went to view Quay Road AI and it looks great. Moore stated there had been a semi flip on it last week and the road held up without any damage. Commissioner Dowell also agreed that it looks really good.

Richard Primrose, Quay County Manager presented the following correspondence:

1. Tucumcari MainStreet will have a benefit on Saturday, November 17 from 6:00 p.m. to 10 p.m. at the Convention Center.
2. A dinner fundraiser will be held at the Elks' Lodge on Friday, November 9 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. to benefit a group of Quay County students who will be traveling to Normandy next summer.
3. The Courthouse will be closed on Monday, November 12 in honor of Veteran's Day and again on the 22nd and 23rd of November for Thanksgiving.

Ellen White, Quay County Clerk, presented amended commission meeting minutes from the June 8, 2018 meeting to add the name of Stantec as the company that was awarded a bid under the CDBG portion of the minutes. 


