### PRESS RELEASE – QUAY COUNTY CLERK’S OFFICE

The County Clerk will begin certification of the voting machines to be used during the 2024 General Election on Monday, September 30, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commission Chambers of the Quay County Courthouse. The certification will continue throughout the day and week until all machines have been tested and certified. The certification is open to the public

Absentee Ballot Applications for the 2024 General Election are now available at the County Clerk’s Office and online at [www.NMVote.org](http://www.NMVote.org). A voter may request to be a “permanent absentee” by marking the appropriate box on the form.

Sample Ballots are now available in the County Clerk’s Office and will be online at [www.NMVote.org](http://www.NMVote.org).

Current voters needing to update or make changes to their current registration must do so in person at the County Clerk’s Office or online at [www.NMVote.org](http://www.NMVote.org) prior to end of day on Tuesday, October 8, 2024

New registrants may register in person at the County Clerk’s Office through Saturday, November 2, during the hours of Early Voting, with appropriate identification and on Election Day at Vote Centers. New registrants may also use the online portal, but the deadline for all registrations at [www.NMVote.org](http://www.NMVote.org) is end of day on Tuesday, October 8.

The online Training Portal for Election Watcher, Challengers and Observers will be available on the NM Secretary of State Website and the Quay County Government Website beginning September 30<sup>th</sup>.

Early and Absentee Voting begins on October 8<sup>th</sup>. Office hours are Monday-Thursday from 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M., as well as Friday, November 1<sup>st</sup> from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The last day an Absentee Application can be processed is Tuesday, October 22. No ballots will be mailed after that deadline.

The Election Boards School of Instruction will be held at the Quay County Exhibit Center on Monday and Tuesday, October 28<sup>th</sup> & October 29<sup>th</sup> beginning at 9:30 a.m.
