Mandatory Post – Election Voting System Check
And
Mandatory Post – Election Recount for Tucumcari City Commission District 4

Pursuant to Section 1-14-13-.2, NMSA 1978, every County in New Mexico is required to perform a Post-Election Voting System Check following a Statewide Election.

The System Check will occur in the Quay County Commission Chambers on Wednesday, November 19, 2025 at 10:00 a.m.

Pursuant to Section 1-14-24-3, NMSA 1978, An automatic recount of the vote is required when the canvass of returns indicates that the margin between the two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes for an office, is less than:

(3) one percent of the total votes cast in that election or five or fewer votes between the two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes for that office in the case of any other office.

A recount board will be convened in the Quay County Commission Chambers, on Tuesday, December 2, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. to begin to assemble the documents necessary for a Recount of the ballots cast for Tucumcari City Commission District 4. The tallying and count of those ballots will occur at approximately 11:00 a.m. when the Tenth Judicial District Judge is available to open the ballot bags to retrieve the ballots.

The public is welcome to attend both the Voting System Check on November 19th and the Recount on December 2.
